SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

Celebrations:

- The in-person Christmas Eve service with the choir
- Members who stepped forward in leadership rolls—Marilyn Paulson as Worship Coordinator, Dave Schafer and Dave Struensee as Ruling Elders Class of 2024, and Bette Hoytink as Clerk

Bette Hoytink was elected as Clerk of Session for the oneyear term of 2022. An assistant clerk will be identified, elected and trained to assume the role in 2023.

Session approved the purchase of a new banner bearing the name of the church. It will be hung by the village at or near the corner of 3rd Avenue and Main Street as part of the village project to install all new banners along Main Street.

The 2022 operating budget was approved. Total income is projected at \$108,500. Total expenses projected to be \$80,470. When a new pastor is hired, the expenses will be increased.

Due to the unavailability of the Moderator, Session did not meet in February. An electronic vote was taken to approve the Annual Statistical Report (sent to the denominational office) and also approve the date of February 27th for the ordination and installation of new Ruling Elders and Deacons.

MEMBER CARE

Reflecting on Jessica's sermon last Sunday, the first Sunday in Lent, it seems a good idea to reinforce the importance and meaning of:

WELCOME, CONNECT, UNDERSTAND, ACT These are words of action, and your Deacons are charged with responsibilities that demand action of various kinds. These 4 actions may help us to focus.

CONNECT with some websites if you need ideas during this season:

1. <u>presbyterianmission.org</u>

Click on Lenten Devotional for 2022. You can click on a weekby-week presentation and may download Devotional if you wish.

2. <u>pres-outlook.org</u>

Click on "Making the Road". Walking Through Lent is a 6 week set of Lenten Devotions that includes daily reflections and prayers. At this website you can sign up with your email address to receive Presbyterian news and free lectionary studies in your inbox. Selecting WORSHIP RESOURCES offers a weekly Christian Ed. lesson - excellent for families and sharing with children and grandchildren.

3. saltproject.org

This Christian site comes out of Indianapolis and has inspiring art, poetry, stories, music, interactive choices. They offer a devotional you can download titled VINCENT VAN GOGH AND THE BEAUTY OF LENT, as one example. It's not specifically Presbyterian, but is a faith-filled place and safe.

To UNDERSTAND what each of us needs spiritually and to seek ways to accomplish filling those needs is in large part what your Member Care Team is dedicated to doing. Please let us know how we can help you, and if you're not someone who uses the internet, tell your Deacon if you need a book, guide, devotional, or something to take you through your Lenten journey.

We will ACT on behalf of our church family in whatever ways we can and however often we can to be there for everyone. God bless our church and everyone in it as we explore Lent this season.

ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING AND UKRAINE

In this Lenten season, our mission focus turns to the One Great Hour of Sharing Offering. This is the single largest way that Presbyterians come together every year to work for a better world. Each gift to One Great Hour of Sharing helps improve the lives of the suffering and vulnerable through three life-saving programs:

- Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA)
- Presbyterian Hunger Program
- Self-Development of People

OGHS was originally started in response to refugees coming out of Europe following WWII. In 2022, we have an opportunity to provide aid and support to the thousands of Ukrainian citizens who are fleeing to other European countries, as well as those who are being displaced within Ukraine.

In the midst of the chaos in Ukraine, PC(USA) has ecumenical partners who are already providing assistance with basic items for survival. Initial assistance being provided includes shelter, food, clothing, blankets, baby food and diapers, other hygiene supplies, flashlights and candles, generators, and fuel. The response of Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to the situation in Ukraine will include both financial and technical assistance as the network of faith communities providing humanitarian assistance grows in the months ahead.

Gifts to the One Great Hour of Sharing Offering will be used to help the relief efforts in Ukraine. Offering envelopes will be available in the pews during Lent. If you wish to make a more immediate gift to the needs for Ukraine, you may do the following:
