In western Christian tradition Epiphany, sometimes known as Three Kings Day, is celebrated on January 6. It follows Christmastide (the Twelve Days of Christmas) between December 25 and January 5 and is the climax of the Advent/Christmas season. It celebrates the revelation of Jesus Christ to Gentiles through the Magi who were the first gentile/non-Jewish people to encounter the Christ child. This revelation indicates that Jesus came to save all people.

The term epiphany means "to show", "to make known", or even "to reveal". In our liturgical year, "The Season of Epiphany" begins with hearing about the Baptism of our Lord. We will then look ahead to the mission of the church in the world in light of the Nativity. The season lasts until the beginning of Lent (Ash Wednesday, February 14th).

One way we can celebrate the season is in the giving of our annual Per Capita giving as a way to celebrate our connectional nature and work as Presbyterians. Each member is encouraged to support our local church, the presbytery, the synod, and the general assembly through an annual contribution of \$38.95 (this year's per capita amount per member).


