• AS PART OF THE WATER MAIN AND SEWER PROJECT ON MEADOW LANE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE CHURCH, WATER LATERALS TO PRIVATE PROPERTY ARE ALSO BEING REPLACED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE. THERE ARE WATER LATERALS TO BOTH THE CHURCH AND THE FELLOWSHIP HALL, WHICH WILL RESULT IN AN ESTIMATED CHURCH EXPENSE OF \$7,000.

• THE WORK ON THE WATER LINES TO THE CHURCH RESULTED IN A LEAK AT THE LARGE COFFEE MAKER STATION IN THE KITCHEN. THE WATER SUPPLY TO THAT FAUCET HAS BEEN TURNED OFF.

• MAINTENANCE RECENTLY COMPLETED INCLUDES CAULKING AND PAINTING OF SEVERAL WINDOWS, CLEANING OF THE GUTTERS AND GARDEN BEDS, AND EDGING THE SIDEWALK WITH THE HELP OF BEN HARMON, WHO ALSO KEEPS THE GRASS MOWED.

 $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ REPAIRS TO THE CEILING OF THE STORAGE ROOM UNDER THE SANCTUARY STEPS ARE NEEDED BEFORE WINTER.

 \cdot 40% OF THE PENTECOST OFFERING (\$194) WAS GIVEN TO THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE BACK-TO-SCHOOL FAIR.

• SESSION APPROVED AN ADDITIONAL PAYMENT OF \$500 FROM THE LOCAL MISSION BUDGET BE PAID TO THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN PREPARATION FOR THE 2024 BACK-TO-SCHOOL EVENT.

• IN ORDER TO CONTINUE WITH THE MONTHLY THRIFT AND GIFT COMMITMENT IN 2024, ADDITIONAL VOLUNTEERS WILL BE NEEDED ON A REGULAR BASIS FOR THE 4TH SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH. IF YOU ARE WILLING TO WORK, PLEASE CONTACT A MEMBER OF SESSION.

• THE NEW SECRETARY/MEDIA PERSON, SHONDA, HAS RESUMED HER PRIMARY JOB WITH THE OSHKOSH SCHOOL SYSTEM AND IS COMPLETING THE CHURCH TASKS REMOTELY FROM HER HOME.

 \cdot JACKIE, OUR BOOKKEEPER, HAS REQUESTED TO STEP DOWN FOR PERSONAL REASONS. SHE WILL STAY ON TO TRAIN HER REPLACEMENT.

• WE NEED TO FORM A NOMINATING COMMITTEE TO INVITE MEMBERS TO SERVE EITHER AS A DEACON OR RULING ELDER. THE COMMITTEE MUST INCLUDE ONE CURRENT ELDER, ONE CURRENT DEACON AND A MEMBER OF THE CONGREGATION-AT-LARGE. MELISSA HARMON HAS VOLUNTEERED TO BE THE RULING ELDER MEMBER OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE.

SUMMER SUNDAY PSALMS

Many thanks to all who suggested favorite psalms, and to our Pulpit Supply preachers for giving us insightful and hopeful messages about "The Prayerbook of God's People."

In introducing the Book of Psalms we learned that it is the only book in the Bible that was actually written directly to God over a period of nearly 1,000 years. Through the Psalms we discovered the power of prayer, acknowledgement of pain, the power of praise, and the assurances and reassurances of God's promises.

The Book of Psalms is a collection of five books. The major categories are Thanksgiving, Lament, Praise, Trust, and Psalms of David. We heard some of each throughout the summer series. We learned about who God is, what God does for us, and how we should respond.

God is our helper, keeper, guide and protector in all times and all places on our life's journey. God is knowable and visible. God keeps God's promises. God's love is consistent and lasts forever. Our response to God is genuine and heartfelt thanksgiving praise. As children of God, in the eyes of God who formed us, we are unique and special. When we experience uncertainty, fear, anger, or despair God is with us. We respond with praise and joy and gratitude. And we reach out in love for others and all of creation, just as God has loved us. The best way for us to know God is to know each other and see God in everyone we meet.

If you wish to revisit any of the Psalms from our series for your own personal meditation, they are Psalms 1, 8, 23, 25, 29, 42, 50, 100, 104, 116, 121, 139, 150.
