- Voted to endorse Kristina Mosley to Winnebago
 Presbytery to be trained to preside at the table
 for Holy Communion in our church for 2023.

WINNEBAGO PRESBYTERY MEETING SUMMARY

SEPTEMBER 22, 2022

A meeting of the Winnebago Presbytery was held at Covenant Community Presbyterian Church in Schofield on Thursday, September 22, 2022. It was a hybrid meeting, so about half of commissioners met in person, and half joined via Zoom.

.

Presbytery took the following actions:

- Motions were made to begin to formally dissolve two churches: First Riverside Presbyterian Church, Merrill, WI, and Keil Presbyterian Church, Keil, WI. The Leadership Commission was given authority to appoint Administrative commissions to work with each congregation. (It was noted that the Administrative Commission assisting in the dissolution New Franken Presbyterian Church had completed its work in May 2022.) <u>Please lift prayers for the members, leaders, and staff of these congregations as they move forward.</u>
- M/S/P to elect Sue Buck (RE, Frame Memorial Church, Stevens Point) as Presbytery Moderator for 2023, and Rev. Matt Sauer (TE, Manitowoc) as Vice Moderator for 2023.
- M/S/P to approve recommendations for changes to the Standing Rules for Presbytery to align with the recently revised Manual of Operations, and that Leadership Commission can proceed with the revisions. Among the proposed changes are to recreate a Nominating Committee, and reinstate the Committee on Representation. Final changes and subsequent voting will take place at the November meeting.
- Leadership Commission in partnership with Transitional General Presbyter Dave Colby have begun a process to accomplish several tasks identified during this transition time as important work for the presbytery to consider/complete before beginning the formal search process for a permanent General Presbyter. The process will be completed by June 2023 so the official search process can begin.
- Presbytery voted to accept setting the 2023 per capita rate at \$38.00/member.
- New minimum terms of call for new clergy were approved, and current clergy members will receive a 5% raise.
- Items for information:
 - There will be 33 amendments to vote on from the 225th General Assembly, including a revision of the entire Rules of Discipline in the Book of Order. Presbytery is planning information sessions for next year.
 - Conversations have begun with Milwaukee and John Knox Presbyteries about possible collaborations going forward. They are also in transitions seeking new General Presbyters.

The next meeting of Winnebago Presbytery will be via Zoom on November 10, 2022.

THE WINNECONNE COOKBOOK @1913

MEATLOAF

- Grind 2 1/2 lbs. round steak and 1 lb salt pork together.
- Add 3 eggs to the mixture.
- Put 1/2 loaf of stale bread in cold water to soak.
- Lift bread out of water, being careful to not squeeze.
- Pull apart the bread into pieces and add to mixture. Mix well.
- Season with pepper and salt.
- Bake in a long narrow pan for 1 to 1 1/2 hours.


TIPS FOR SANDWICHES

On Sunday, October 2nd, the church will celebrate World Communion Sunday.
