DAILY DEVOTIONAL FOR LENT

It is designed to help the "pilgrim" know their local community better. It encourages one to explore places beyond one's everyday experiences. It is a "sacred exercise in attending to whatever God lays before us in our lives and our communities."

A LENTEN STUDY: The Women who Followed Jesus

The four Gospels of the New Testament mention many women who played a vital role in Jesus' ministry. Some are named and some are not. Some were healed, some traveled with him, some were very close, others simply followed, and some were at the cross and witnessed his death and resurrection.

Jesus' encounters with these women crossed social, cultural, and religious boundaries of the time, yet they were important in demonstrating the essence of his ministry and mission to reveal who God is.

We are exploring some of their stories and reflecting on what they teach us about Jesus and about our own faith. The class began after worship on Feb. 25, and continues on March 3, 17, and 24.

Readings for the remaining sessions will be included in the weekly email updates through March. The topics to be covered are:

March 3 – Women at the Tomb and the Resurrection March 11 – no class (enjoy Deacon's fellowship after worship) March 17 – The Woman with the Ointment (as portrayed in all four Gospels) March 24 – "All the Mary's" – (there will be a reading handout available for this session.)

The weekly sermons are also highlighting some of the women who followed Jesus.
