SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

The Session did not meet in April but held a special meeting on March 28th.

Session received the notice from Communications and Media Consultant, Kristen Deadwyler, that her last Sunday coordinating the live streaming of the worship service will be April 24th. She is willing to continue doing the remote communications work until a replacement is found. Session approved a motion to post a position for an office administrator, who will work up to 20 hours per week, covering office and communication responsibilities, but not the Sunday morning live stream.

Session authorized the purchase of a Zoom account for the church. This is to be used by the Pastor Nominating Committee and other groups in the church.

Session approved the use of the fellowship hall by the Bible Baptist Church for a meal on Palm Sunday afternoon, April 10th.

Session approved June 5th and 12th, and August 7th and 14th as vacation Sundays for organist, Linda Harmon.

PENTECOST SUNDAY - JUNE 5, 2022

Each year on Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the church. The Holy Spirit remains with us still, connecting us with the church of the past, continuing to inspire the church of today, and pointing us to the church of the future. Each year this celebration is marked by receiving the Pentecost Offering, which nurtures the faith of those who are the church to come.

In this season of new awakening, we look particularly to children, youth and young adults for their new thoughts, approaches, and questions. The psalmist reminds us that faith is established in our earliest years, saying, "For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O Lord, from my youth." These youngest members of the household of faith need our support to reach their full potential in faith and life. We all have important roles to play in their journey. And while we teach and lead, we often find that these younger ones give us new insights into our own faith and in how the Holy Spirit is moving in our world. Your gifts to the Pentecost Offering support ministries with children, youth, and young adults in Winneconne, across the nation and around the world.

As we prepare to receive the Pentecost Offering on Sunday, June 5th, remember that 40% of the gifts remain in our community to support ministries with younger people. This year, we plan to use our 40% to support the Winneconne schools backpack program sponsored by the Winneconne Area Assistance Center (WAAC). This program provides food for over 200 children on weekends, so they don't go hungry when they are not in school. The remainder of the offering is forwarded to the denomination so that young adults can form a foundation for their lives through a year of service in the Young Adult Volunteer Program and youth can be among the 5,000-plus having mountaintop experiences in worship, play and faith formation at events like the Presbyterian Youth Triennium, which our own Robbie Mosley attended in 2019.

In the Book of Jeremiah, the prophet shares the statement, "I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord,....to give you a future with hope" (Jeremiah 29:11). These striking, comforting words reminded the Israelites that, despite their present experience, God's gesture, thoughts, and plans for them—and for us—are peaceful, abundant and hopeful. At Pentecost, we celebrate that God offers more than we can plan. Our gifts to the Pentecost Offering connect with God's hope and future, supporting ministries with children, youth and young adults. Please prayerfully consider a generous gift to this special mission offering.


